

Moving with Your Dog

What to Pack Checklist

Easily Accessible



Leash	If you do not keep the collar on your dog in the crate, keep it on the leash. Use the leash at all times.	
Crate	Make sure crate meets travel requirements. Use crate in hotels & new environments when dog is left alone.	
Medication	Bring necessary medication in bottles with prescription labels attached.	
Bed or Blanket	If you have room, bring your dog's bed if she uses one. Provide a blanket in winter for warmth.	
Water Bowl & Water	Bring an unbreakable bowl and fresh water.	
Poop Bags	Be considerate and bring a sufficient supply of poop bags.	
Paper Towels & Wet Wipes	For clean up for yourself and your dog.	

Accessible



Vet Records & Microchip Info	If you are flying, you'll need to have this easily accessible.	
Food Bowl	Bring an unbreakable & easy to clean bowl.	
Food	Bring your dog's regular food in an airtight container.	
Treats	Not necessary unless your dog is very food motivated.	
One or Two Toys	There's no need to bring lots of toys. Bring a toy to exercise your dog and provide stress relief.
